

Dormant Sod Care Sheet

- Dormant Sod is sod that had gone into hibernation for the cold winter months. Once spring arrives the grass will begin to turn green.
- Dormant Sod is an excellent choice to prevent erosion, mud tracking and for lawns that need to look good before spring.
- Dormant Sod should be watered thoroughly upon installation and remain moist through out the winter. This is not difficult since the days are not as hot. You can check the soil moisture by pulling up the edges of the sod. The sod will not grow much during the cold months of winter. However root damage could occur if allowed to dry out to much.
- Once the Dormant Sod begins to green in the spring follow the instruction for your specific sod.
